San Bernardino County Fair



I hope you all have been setting aside pieces to enter in the 2024 San Bernardino County Fair this year. The theme is "Truckloads of Fun!" I don't have the timelines just yet. Generally, submissions need to be registered around the 15th of April.

The cost to enter is \$2.00 per item. What a deal! Remember, you will compete with fellow painters at the same skill level as you. There are four levels - Novice (1-3 years experience), Intermediate (4-9 years experience), Advanced (10+ years experience), and Professional (a person who paints as a livelihood i.e. teachers). I hope that each of you will consider entering at least one piece this year. This is a way for us to show our craft to the public and, hopefully, gain some new painters along the way!

I will again offer to accept entries from our members who live out of the San Bernardino County area. Just let me know if you would like to participate and I will provide you with my address for you to use when entering. Also, if you need help in getting your item(s) to the fair on the dates listed above, please contact me. I will be happy to pick them up at a prearranged place and deliver them to the fair. The same goes for picking them up and returning them to you when the time comes.

This hint has been taken from the Facebook page of Tracy Moreau...thank you Tracy for sharing it with us!

Do you have a pile of tiny pieces to paint? They are a pain, but here is a way to make them behave—Repositional Glue Dots! Arrange a few dots all over a piece of cardboard or

scrap wood. Stick the tiny pieces to a dot while it is on the cardboard or scrap wood. Press firmly!

Now go ahead and sponge, roll or spray the tiny pieces with the paint color of your choice. Once done, the tiny pieces can be removed from the glue dots. If the dot follows, it can be simply peeled off the back. Enjoy!!
