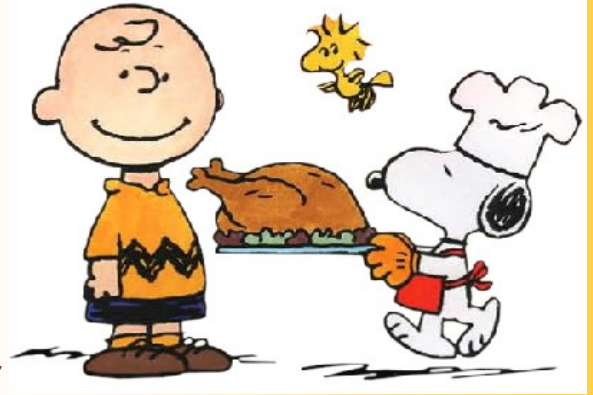

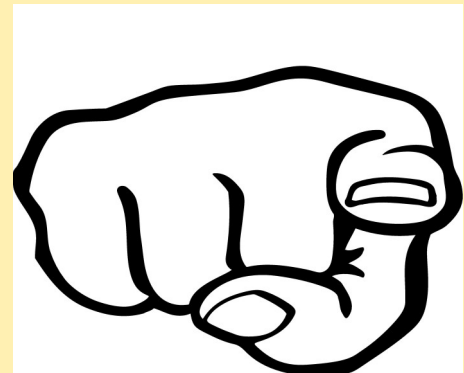

EXAMPLE FOR REDUCING: Your pattern is 15-inches long and you need to make it 12-inches long. Simply take 12, divide by 15 which equals 0.8, then multiply that by 100 for a total of 80. Now you can set the copier or scanner to reduce at 80%.

EXAMPLE FOR ENLARGING: Your pattern is 12-inches long and you want to enlarge it to 15-inches. Take 15, divide it by 12 which equals 1.25, then multiply that by 100 for a total of 125. So now you can set the scanner or copier to enlarge by 125%.

"Here's a hint for your other followers: When mixing colors, I usually end up with too much paint and I hate to waste anything. My old garden tools have lost the finish on their handles, resulting in cracking and splinters.



I clean up one tool at a time and keep it in my studio, where I use my leftover paint to decorate the handle. When I'm finished, I put on a coat of sealer and bring in the next tool. No waste and eventually all of my garden tools will be protected and easier to see in the yard." I told her I loved her for sharing this. Isn't that cool?

The meeting was called to order by President, Janet Mitchell, at 6:37 p.m

Programs: Sue Clark and Diana VanRiel –All of the 2017 teachers are now in place. January 2017 will be a mystery project taught by Sue Clark, February will be taught by Diana Tyner, March will be taught by Tami Carmody, April will be taught by Barbara Underwood. (makes 25 squares)

Ingredients

- 1 box brownie mix (not family sized), prepared according to package directions 9x9 pan
- ½ cup chopped salted or honey roasted peanuts
- 12 peanut butter cups, chopped
- 2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 Tbsp butter
- 1 heaping cup creamy peanut butter (or 1¼ cups)
- 1¾ cups crispy rice cereal
- 1 tsp vanilla
- ½ tsp – 1 tsp kosher salt

Instructions

- Bake brownies according to package directions in a 9x9 pan lined with foil.
- During the last 5 minutes of baking, remove from oven and sprinkle chopped peanut butter cups and chopped peanuts on top. Return to oven for remaining 5 minutes to melt the chocolate.
- As soon as you pull them out of the oven, spread the melted peanut butter cups/peanuts with an off-set spatula to smooth over top. Let brownies cool.
- Next in a microwave safe bowl combine chocolate chips, peanut butter and butter. Heat in microwave for 1 minute, stirring when done. If needed, continue heating in 20 second increments until chocolate chips are melted.
- Stir in cereal, vanilla and salt until evenly combined.
- Pour over brownies and smooth. Chill until chocolate is set, about 2 hours.
- Cut into squares to serve.

Notes

Store airtight for up to 3 days. You can store these at room temperature or in refrigerator.
