


Treasurer's Report submitted by Cathy Duke-Immel

Tips: For Preparation

Tip: If transfer lines cannot be removed with an eraser, remove them with a cotton swab or brush and odorless thinner, When working with acrylics, rinse the area with water after using thinner,

Tip: Realize that masking the edges of your painting with brightly colored painter's tape (blue, purple, green) will greatly influence the painting process since COLOR and VALUE are ALWAYS relevant to those that surround them (an oftentimes to-tally clash with the painting). Use clear or neutral tapes to avoid this problem. **Tip:** For the greatest accuracy, always cut tracing and transfer paper down to the

same size or smaller than the painting surface. Papers hanging off the edges inhibit accurate placement and shift easily. Secure with tape in two places.

Tip: To transfer teeny objects (like bugs), carefully ink the design on tracing paper, turn over and carefully trace the inked design with a soft pencil. Place the inked side up on the surface and transfer using a small stylus. This will be much more accurate than using transfer paper which adds another layer between you and the design!

Tip: When painting animals, choose white transfer paper when possible. If white will not work, use gray. Colored transfer papers (especially blue) are not a good choice as the color mixes into the fur color as you paint!

Tip: To fill the very rough cross grain areas of wood which show up on the blunt end of wood or on beveled wood edges, paint on wood filler that has been thinned with lots of water so that it soaks into the rough grain. Dry and repeat several times or as needed. (un-thinned filler tends to ride atop the rough wood and flakes off immediately when sanded. The watery filler will soak down into every pore and be solidly smooth.)

Tip: Undercoat lampshades with black paint to prevent light shinning through the surface and illuminating every stroke and blotch.

Tip: Transfer paper is not meant to be used "as is" directly from the package. Always wipe the excess off the back with a soft paper towel before first time use. This avoids harsh transfer lines and hard to removes smudges on your surface!
