

Tips: For Preparation

TIP: There Layers of base paint will allow you to remove rough edges in your painting by lightly scraping with an X-Acto knife and still not go thought the base color.

This also works to remove unwanted smears, thin lines such as stems that are too thick, ect.... a great "safety net" if you don't always get it right the first time!

TIP: Try painting on a decoupage background.... So fun and easy for newsprint, music, etc... ModPodge your background image, seal with 2 coats of Modpodge, varnish to further seal, dry transfer your design and paint!

TIP: Careful tracing and transferring of people or animals can make or break a project. Always trace/transfer the eyes, nose, moth first. Next, trace/transfer the delicate parts such as ankles or fingers...then the rest of the design. If anything shifts as you work, you have accurately established the important parts first!

TIP: Use a wax free transfer paper such as Saral. It erases like pencil with no smudging and can be inked or painted over with no skipping or bleeding. On fabric, it can be sponged, washed, or brushed orr, and will not set with ironing. Look for it in rolls at fine art stores.

TIP: Spray base painted surfaces with matte acrylic sealer before transferring the design. This protects the surface and allows you to correct and "clean-up" a design without staining or harming the underlying base paint. Always allow the spray to cure sufficiently, as transferring too early may promote harsh graphite lines.

TIP: Use your softest brushes for base painting and undercoating. Stiff brushes tend to pick up as much paint as they deposit! Also, always use as large a brush as possible for the space.

TIP: Re-purpose old metal by first prepping with a coat of acrylic primer such as JoSonja's Ultra Cover or Under Cover from JW,. Then paint as usual! These products provide excellent adhesion and are available in white or black and may be tinted with color.

TIP: Use a kneaded eraser to lighten overly dark transfer lines before painting. They do not smudge as badly as other types of erasers and leave no mussy eraser stuff. If erasing does not lighten the lines sufficiently, apply a thinned base coat (so as to be semi-transparent) over the transferred pattern. The lines will still be visible, but not nearly as dark.

Since our February meeting is after Valentine Day and before St. Patrick's day we will celebrate St. Patrick's Day.


Bring your favorite GREEN food. It can have green in the title, green in the dish or be your favorite Irish dish.


