



Hello everyone...





APPLE SAUCE COOKIES

- 1 CUP OF SUGAR
- 1/2 CUP OF SHORTENING
- 1 EGG
- 2 TEASPOONS OF BAKING SODA
- 1 1/2 TEASPOONS OF BAKING POWDER
- 1 1/2 CUPS OF FLOUR
- 1 1/2 TEASPOON OF GROUND CLOVES
- 1 TEASPOON OF CINNAMON
- 2 1/4 CUP FLOUR
- 1 CUP OR RAISINS OR CRANRAISINS

Cream SUGAR and SHORTENING, then add an EGG.

Meanwhile dissolve BAKING SODA in the APPLESAUCE.

Combine BAKING POWDER, GROUND CLOVES, and CINNAMON and mix well, then add APPLESAUCE and mix well.

Add FLOUR a 1/2 CUP at a time, mix well.

Drop by teaspoon on to cookie sheet (I use parchment paper)

Set OVEN to 300 - BAKE for 15 - 18 minutes till golden brown.
