



CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by **Nancy Schatz**, President, at 9:04 am. Other members present were **Jeannetta Cimo (1/2)**, **Marilyn Hinman**, Janet Mitchell, **Rosanne Scholey (1/2)**, **Kim Tamiazzo**, **Diana Van Riel**, and **Carol Whitton**. (Bold = Board Officer)

BOARD OF DIRECTORS' REPORTS

President. Nancy thanked everyone in attendance. Discussion followed as to how often we should meet as a Board. It was decided to hold monthly meetings for now.

1st Vice President (Programs). Rosanne Scholey reported that the Church has changed times available to use their facility. It was decided to change our meeting time on the 4th Tuesday of each month to 1-4 pm with the option of extending the ending time to 5 pm, if needed.

2nd Vice President (Membership). It was decided that new members will be recognized at meetings and in the newsletter. Kim Tamiazzo stated the Membership binder needed to be located.

Secretary. The minutes of November 2, 2021 were emailed to members prior to the meeting. There was a correction on page 3, **Next Meeting**. The date should read Wednesday, December 29, 2021 not Tuesday, January 4, 2022. **A motion was made by Rosanne Scholey and seconded by Janet Mitchell to approve the minutes as corrected. The motion carried.**

Treasurer. Marilyn Hinman reported she needs someone to do the audit so she can close the books for 2021. Jeannetta Cimo volunteered. Marilyn also reported the rent for the church will stay the same, \$150.00 per month. She requested that Board Members and Committee Chairs send their needs to her for the 2022 budget. A discussion followed regarding using PayPal to process fees for dues and programs. There are only two people presently who are authorized to invoice from PayPal, Marilyn and Rosanne. It was decided that Rosanne will do all the invoicing to keep things simple and limit the number of people accessing the PayPal account.


Charities/Community Service

Education

Fellow Painters, have you ever looked at your paint palette when you were done for the day and wondered what you could do with the leftover paint? Sue Getto posted the following tip I found intriguing.

I am often asked what I do with left over paint on my palette. I like to keep one or more canvases at the ready by giving them a wash of background color (usually black) and then I use a small palette knife to transfer the leftover paint from the palette onto the canvas. I might give it a wash over and in some places the paint will be a bit thicker. When the canvas reaches a point where it is mostly covered, I then work it into an abstract of sorts, adding colors here and there, building a bit more interest. I might work on it for weeks or even months and then to bring it all together (the fun part) I will use diluted colors and a brush to tone down some of the colors. You can also use this method to de-stress, it is a fact that colors make us feel more creative and happy, so next time you find yourself in a painting slump, give it a try. I will finish this with a coat or two of very high gloss varnish or even resin. I have these pops of color in one area of my home and they never fail to cheer me.

May also be a great way to dabble in abstract painting! Let's see some canvases with left over paint!

We recommend your project photo be taken with proper lighting, contrasting background and full-frame (as close-up as possible with minimal background showing). Up to 3 photos per project may be submitted to show all project sides.

- **Project selection:** Projects are voted on by the Brush Whacker members and the projects that receive the most votes are offered at the Get-Away.
- **Project fee:** For all classes that are selected, teachers are required to provide students with prepped surfaces, patterns, instructions, photos, class paint and any materials needed to complete the project (i.e., glue, DecoPage, screws, hanging wire, material for bows, etc.). Teachers should include the cost of these items in their project fee. Project fees are paid directly to teachers by their students at the Get-Away.
- **Specialty items:** Teachers should list any specialty items students need to bring to class on the project description information sheet. Teachers may sell specialty items (stencils, stamps, brushes, etc.) to their students at the Get-Away. Teachers will be provided with the email addresses of their students so they may contact the students and take pre-orders of specialty items prior to the get-away if they wish.
- **Class size:** Maximum number of students per class is 15. If you have a minimum of 8 students enrolled in your class at the registration deadline, you are under contract to teach that class. If there are less than 8 students enrolled, it will be your choice whether to teach the class or not.
- **Class fee:** Teachers will receive \$15.00 per student for a 3-hour class and \$25.00 per student for a 6-hour class. Teachers receive class fees for all registered students including any "no shows".
- **Classroom:** Teachers will need to bring any equipment they wish to use to teach (i.e., camera, projector, screen, extension cords, power strips, etc.). Tables will be provided by the resort. All classes will be held in a large ballroom. Students will be seated two to a table. A staging area will be available to store your class materials. Please label your boxes clearly.
- **Registration:** We would love for our teachers to not only teach at our event but attend classes as well. *Teachers that choose to stay at the resort for the entire event and pay the full food and lodging fees will have the \$25 registration fee waived.* However, if you choose to teach only, you will need to pay the \$25 registration fee. *We would encourage you to join us for meals as the painting rooms are paid for by meeting our food and room expense guarantee.* Please email me with any questions about individual meal or room costs.
