1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Beth Murena, President, at 9:30 am. Other members present were Becky Bolding, Jeannetta Cimo (1/2), Marilyn Hinman, Janet Mitchell, Terri Mullin, Nancy Schatz, Rosanne Scholey (1/2), Diana Van Riel, and Carol Whitton. (Bold = Board Officer)

It was clarified that in order to take action at Board meetings, the Bylaws state, “A majority shall constitute a quorum.” Since there are seven (7) Board positions, a quorum would be established if four (4) members are present. If a position is shared and both members are present, only one (1) will be counted as it relates to the quorum.

2. BOARD OF DIRECTORS’ REPORTS

a. President. Beth shared she spoke with a member of the High Desert Republican Women. At their upcoming meeting, they have invited vendors to bring items to sell. The cost is 15% of sales or \$25. Vendors must bring their own table. Anyone interested may contact Beth. She will also type up information so it may be placed in the October newsletter.

b. 1st Vice President (Programs). Rosanne reported they have everything set for the Mystery Teacher on October 18th. They have received the November prep instructions but will hold off on sending them out until it’s closer to the date. They have been working on classes for 2022. Zoom is allowing them to schedule Big Brushes. Deb Mishima will be teaching in March 2022.

c. 2nd Vice President (Membership). Terri asked about dues for 2022. Those present agreed there is no reason to raise them for this year as our treasury is solid. Dues will remain at \$10. Terri will write up an article and place form in newsletter. If information has not changed for current members, they will not have to resubmit a form but will need to verify their SDP membership for 2022.

d. Secretary. The minutes of July 6, 2021 were presented at the August 3, 2021 meeting but could not be approved due to a lack of a quorum. **A motion was made by Rosanne Scholey and seconded by Marilyn Hinman to approve the July 6, 2021 minutes as presented. The motion carried.** Carol read the minutes of August 3, 2021. **A motion was made by Terri Mullin and seconded by Rosanne Scholey to approve the August 3, 2021 minutes as presented. The motion carried.**

e. Treasurer. Marilyn corrected the figures presented for the Treasurer’s Report on August 3, 2021. **A motion was made by Rosanne Scholey and seconded by Terri Mullin to approve the Treasurer’s Report as presented. f. Newsletter Editor. Nancy Schatz asked that newsletter articles be submitted to her by October 7, 2021.

g. Ways and Means. No report.

3. COMMITTEE REPORTS

a. Charities. Not present. Discussion followed regarding donating money to Today's Woman since we have not donated to a charity other than the church this year. **It was moved by Rosanne Scholey and seconded by Diana Van Riel that we donate \$250 to Today's Woman. The motion carried.**

b. Christmas Party. The Rusty Bull does not have their schedule for December set up yet. When they do, Terri will schedule December 7th. The cost for members will be \$10. DQT will pick up the difference.

c. Community Service. Diana reported this event is still scheduled for the January 2022 meeting at the church.

d. Easter Egg Exchange. Not present.

e. Education. Not present.

f. Fair. No report.

g. Holiday Boutique. Becky reported, "It's a go!"

h. Holiday Raffle. Carol reported ticket sales are going well.

i. Hospitality. Not present.

j. Nominations. Rosanne presented the Slate of Officers for 2022. This will be published in the October 2022 newsletter with elections to be held via email in November. The slate is as follows: President – Nancy Schatz, 1st VP/Programs – Jeannetta Cimo and Rosanne Scholey, 2nd VP/Membership – Kim Latham Tamiazzo, Secretary – Carol Whitton, Treasurer – Marilyn Hinman, Newsletter – Nancy Schatz said she would continue unless someone is willing to take this position, and Ways and Means – Diana Van Riel.

k. October Painting Month. Not present. It was stated that Sue has painters lined up for the boutique.

l. Special Raffles. Not present.

m. Summer Seminar. Rosanne thanked everyone who attended. Becky shared Chris Haughey was a marvelous teacher who taught great techniques. Income for the seminar was \$2860.72 and expenses were \$2728.53.

n. Sunshine. Not present.

o. Website. Carol reported everything is updated.

p. Welcome. Not present.

5. NEW BUSINESS

a. Survey Regarding Change of Meeting Time. There were no Future Agenda Items presented.


7. NEXT MEETING

At our recent board meeting, we discussed moving forward into 2022.
