Well I heard we had a great project with Diana last month! I know that she is a wonderful teacher; I was sad to miss the class.


We have our seminar coming up with Chris Haughey and it is sure to be a great one don't forget to sign up!





Remember to go to Judith Westegaard Designs every day for the newly-mixed substitution The horizontal paint sample across the top is DecoArt's mixing recipe. I again struggled to get my mix correct so I tried theirs and was not satisfied with their formula and started tweaking it. Mine is not perfect but I believe it is much closer. I am including it so you can see the difference.

DecoArt Retired Color Mix O' the Day: Wedgewood Blue is on the left, mix on the right is Deep Midnight Blue + Primary Blue + Thicket (2:2:1)....you're welcome! Remember to go to Judith Westegaard Designs every day for the newly-mixed substitution The horizontal paint sample across the top is DecoArt's mixing recipe of Primary Blue + Thicket (1:1). I struggled to get my mix correct so I tried theirs and was not satisfied with their formula and started tweaking it. Mine is not perfect but I believe it is much closer.
