Do you use Glazing Medium? by Cheryl Poulin

Decorative painters use glazing medium for use with acrylic paints for many purposes. The glazing medium remains open longer than acrylic paints on their own. That allows you to pull off some cool techniques. By open, I mean it slows down the drying process. I'm sure you already knew that. I won't get into all of the techniques right now but they include:

- Wood Graining
- Marbling
- Trompe L'Oeil
- Additive Techniques
- Subtractive Techniques
- Glazing

Acrylic painters use a glazing medium in the same way that oil painters might use linseed oil or turpentine. It helps to thin the paint. It allows you to isolate and preserve paint layers. And it gives you much better results for doing wet-in-wet blending.

If I'm doing straight pin stripes, I'll use tape to ensure I paint a perfect line. Unfortunately, sometimes, paint will seep under the tape, which is so frustrating. But I have a solution.

I like to use glazing medium to create a transparent barrier film between the edge of masking tape and my painted surface.

How do I do that? After burnishing the tape edges down with the back of a spoon, I apply a thin coat of the glazing medium over the edges of the tape. So now effectively, if there was going to be any "bleeding" under the tape, it's the clear medium that has bled and filled in that tiny pocket.

Once dry, I can paint knowing the lines will be perfect every time! Try it yourself!

And here's another little tip...

If you're doing a pen and ink drawing using a permanent pen, sometimes when you apply your finishing varnish, it smears the ink. Ughhh! All of the work gone! Don't you just hate that?

Well I have a solution for that as well. Yes, you guessed it... glazing medium to the rescue! First you can brush on a coat of glazing medium over your drawing without worry of smearing the ink. Then you can apply your varnish over the glazing medium.
