GALAXY GLITTER

Galaxy Glitter is a brush-on glitter acrylic that adds shimmer and shine to craft projects and home décor accents. Specially formulated with the ideal combination of various sizes and colors of glitter.

HOW TO USE-Shake well. Apply with a brush. Allow to dry before adding additional coats. For a more intense color, apply over a similar DecoArt acrylic paint color. Check out the basecoating suggestions below, or experiment with your own color combinations. Water-based. Permanent. Soap and water clean up. **Do not use for fabric painting.**

TIPS-For solid coverage, apply Galaxy Glitter with a fan brush. Allow to dry and apply a second coat.

For fine details or line-work use a liner brush to apply Galaxy Glitters.

Galaxy Glitters are intermixable. Create soft, glittery pastel colors by mixing the color of your choice with Clear Ice Comet. Start with a ratio of 4 parts Clear Ice Comet and 1 part of the color of your choice. Customize to your desired finish.

When working with glitter paint, keep separate brushes and water basins. This will prevent glitter particles from transferring to your other paints or paint brushes.

Apply Clear Ice Comet over the top of any other Galaxy Glitter color to soften the overall appearance and color. Apply Silver Moon over the top to add a silvery sparkle.
