I was looking at Chris Haughey's website and she gave some great suggestions for organizing and working more efficiently so I thought I would start off my tenure as the education guru (hahaha) by sharing some of her ideas:

Clear and clean your work space. Before you start even the smallest project, make sure your workspace is free of clutter and dust. As Chris says..."making sure your area is spotless and tidy not only makes working on projects easier, creativity will also flow much better!

Once you are all clean, get out whatever supplies needed for the next project you are about to begin.

- Now organize your tools, paints and brushes within easy reach. She has suggestions for how to organize, do whatever works best for you—but do some type of organization so you no longer have to stop, search and reach across the room to find something you need at a critical moment. Most importantly regardless of the manner in which you organize your tools, be sure to return them when you are done using them each time you paint...that's the tough part!
- Last, but not least...when you are done with a project—put everything away and again clean-up your work space so you are prepared to begin the next project you are anxious to start with the very clear and clean work space you just spent so much time organizing.


